Frequently asked questions:

• Can I have a bouncy castle?

Of course, although, please be advised that if using inside, then the height from floor to ceiling beam is 2.85m

- What is the jubilee room?
 Our Jubilee Room is the smaller building situated in the car park in front of the main HQ
- Are there jugs, cups and kettle? In the kitchen, there are large jugs, 2 kettles and a continuous hot water boiler. There is also enough cutlery, plates, bowls and mugs for 48 people
- What are the dimensions of hall? Our main hall is 19.7m x 9.8m
- Is there a fridge/freezer I can use? The kitchen contains both an undercounter fridge and separate freezer. Please take any unused food with you after your booking
- Are there kids cups? There are 48 plastic cups in the kitchen

• Are there tables and chairs? Where are they kept?

There are 100 fold up chairs and approximately 24 fold up tables (3' x 2'). Tables are kept on the left-hand side at the far end of the hall. Chairs are on trolleys inside the white double doors at the far end of the hall

- What cleaning equipment do I need to bring? Hoovers, brooms, mops and dustpan and brushes are all in the cleaning cupboard on the left-hand side at the far end of the hall. It is advisable to bring your own bin bags, j cloths and washing up liquid
- Why won't the toilet light turn off? Our toilet lights are all on automatic timers so will turn themselves off after a period of time!

Where are spare toilet rolls and hand towels?

In the cleaning cupboard down the far end of the hall on the left-hand side

• Cooker instructions

Full instructions on how to light the cooker are found in the kitchen. Please ensure that the Gaz bottles on the outside of the HQ are turned on, that the lever behind the cooker is set to on and that the extractor fan is switched on and Gaz shut off switch is pulled out prior to lighting

• What is included on my hire? i.e. Parking, jubilee room, grass field Usual bookings include the main hall, car park and field. The Jubilee room can be added for an extra charge. If using the field, then please be considerate of our neighbours. Thankyou
